

Printing animal kennel cards

A **Kennel Card** is very similar to the animal's web page but without the layout and formatting.

You can print a **Kennel Card** for each animal. Some groups who keep animals in kennels create kennel cards for each cage. Others create a notebook displaying all of their animals. Some organizations use a **Kennel Card** as a permanent, hard-copy record of the animal.

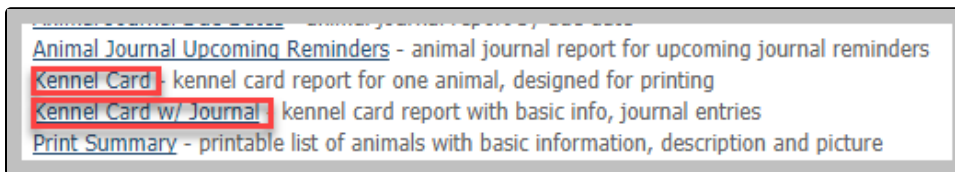

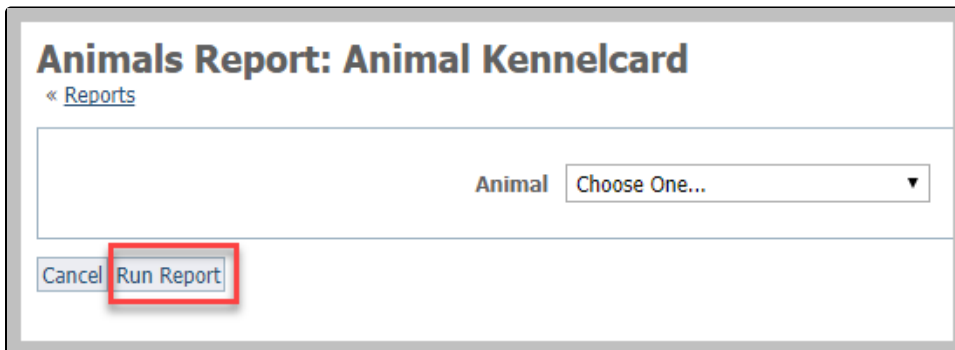

Print a Kennel Card from the Reports page:

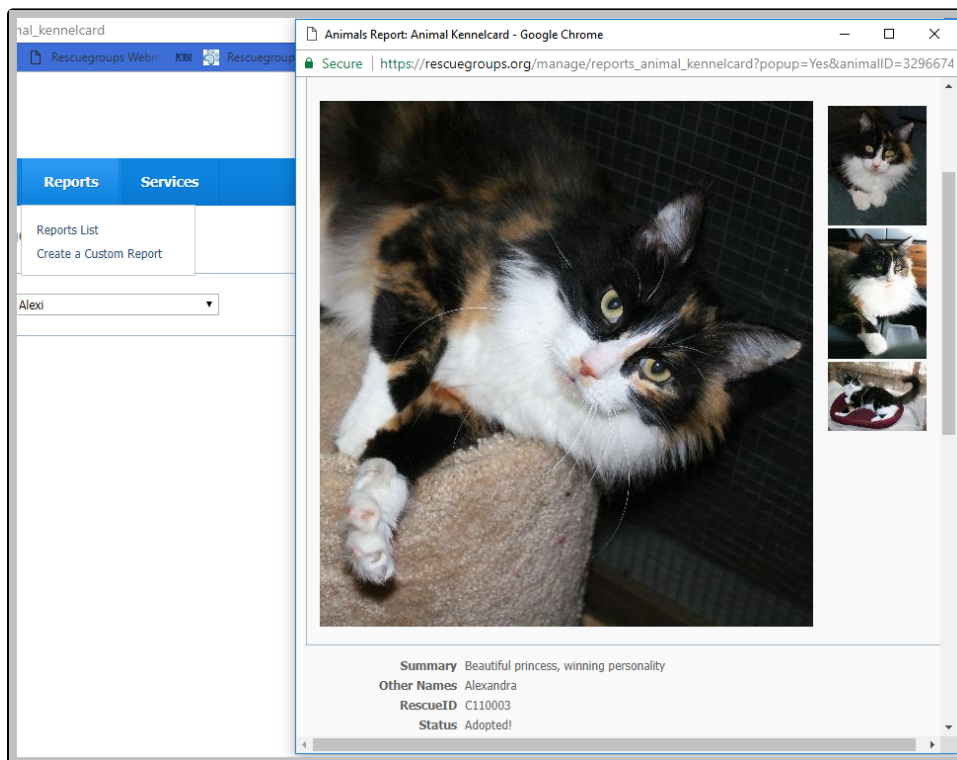
1. Click **Reports** from the top menu bar and select **Reports List**.
2. Scroll down to the two **Kennel Card** selections and choose one.



3. Select one of your organization's animals from the drop-down menu and then click **Run Report**. A popup box displays the **Kennel Card**.



4. From the upper right corner of the popup box, click the **Click to print** link.
