

Adding a code snippet for publicizing upcoming events to your web page

You can add a code snippet to the web page of your choice to publicize upcoming events.



Please only use this if you are comfortable with CSS. If you need assistance, please open a support ticket.

This is one way you can customize the built-in snippet Sidebar Upcoming Events Block. Here's an example of how it would look.



Although the code snippet is called Sidebar Upcoming Events Block, it does not have to be placed as a sidebar and can be placed anywhere on the page.



Follow these instructions to add the sidebar:

1. Upload this image



2. Add this code to your CSS

  display:none;
  text-shadow: 1px 1px 0 #FFFFFFF;
}
.sidebarBox .event {
  font-size: 11px;
  line-height: 3.1;
  margin-left: 2px;
  text-indent:20px;
  background-image: url(http://location of the image );
  background-position: left;
  background-repeat: no-repeat;
}
```
