

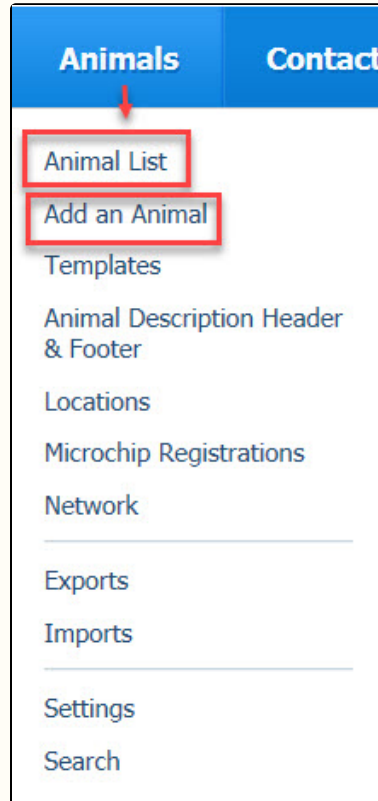
# Animals

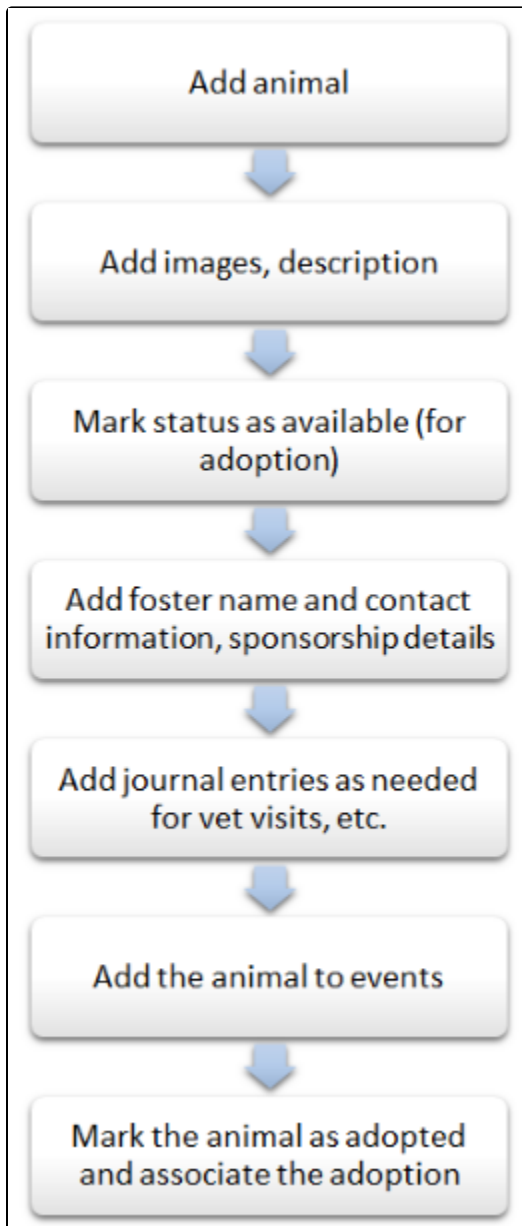
Use the **Animals** menu to add animals to your website and manage all the information available about them. The management features available for animals differ according to your level of service.
