

Editing and Renaming menu items

You can edit menu items that you've added to your custom menus by changing the name or the text.

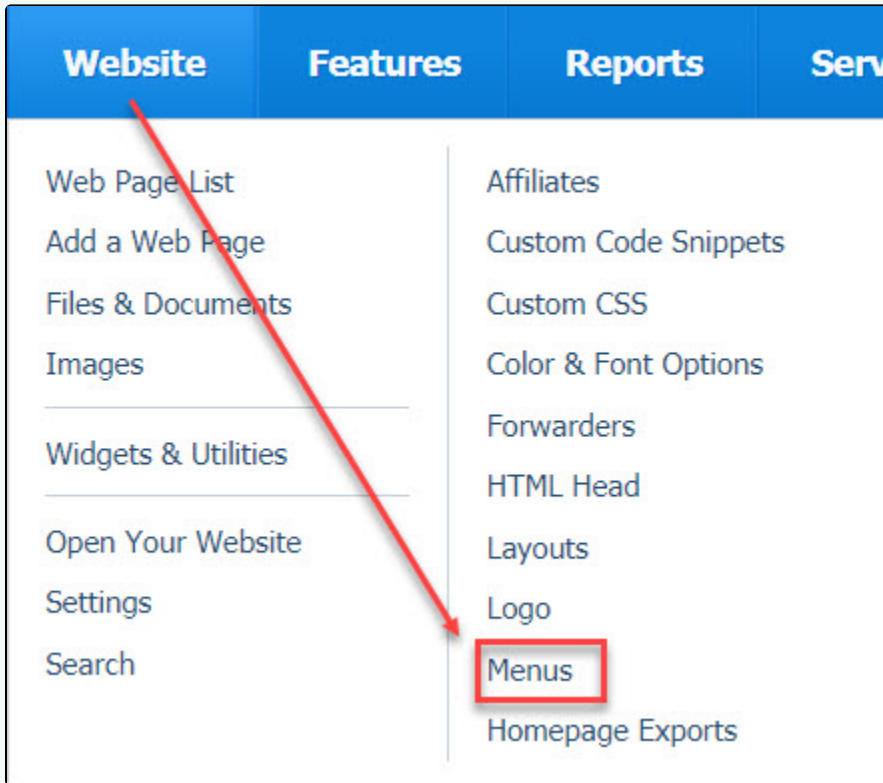
You can also change the order in which the menu items are displayed. For information about changing the order in which menu items appear, see the page [Reordering menu items](#).


Editing menu items

To edit the text of a menu item:

1. Click the **Edit** icon next to the menu item.



2. Change the **Name** of the menu item. The name is what you see on your account interface.
3. Change the **Text**; that is what viewers will see when they visit your website.
4. Click the **Save Web Menu Item** to save your changes
